**Board of Directors Meeting**  
**Monday, November 10, 2025**  
**Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by the President, Kevin Kennelley. The secretary, Martha Mosman, confirmed the meeting was properly warned and that there was a quorum present.

The minutes from the October 20, 2025, Golf Board Meeting were approved and accepted.

The course has suffered damage due to the abundance of rainfall combined with King Tides. Kevin made a request to all members to adhere to the daily rules of play that are in effect to help aid in course recovery.

There will be a Nomination Committee Chairperson to solicit members to run for the golf board. This year there will be two positions open for Riverbend Golf Residents.

Jeff Heward and his staff are faced with challenges due to unprecedented amounts of late summer rainfall and King Tides. Some of the steps taken to ensure the regrowth and recovery of the turfgrass that was lost due to the excessive rainfall.

- Weekly fairway topdressing and liquid fertilizer applications
- Rye grass will be overseeded into all our tees, select fairways, driving range, and practice facility.
- Cart restrictions will be increased during the germination period.
- Coquina will be applied to several cart paths.
- A new meter will be installed to our re-permitted deep well by year's end.

**Ranger Report:** Ken Kotansky

Ken sent out an email requesting volunteers for the ranger assistance program. He is very excited to announce that he now has 25 rangers to call on, including our first non-member starter ranger.
